Communicating with Health Care Staff

Let's face it; sometimes it is hard to talk to doctors and other health care professionals!

So here are a few pointers to help you get the information you need from them.

- \Rightarrow Know your rights and responsibilities.
- \Rightarrow Ask questions!

(Remember: There is no such thing as a stupid question)

 \Rightarrow If you do not understand something ask them to explain it to you again.

(It is their job to make sure you do understand the information)

- \Rightarrow If you need help ask!
- \Rightarrow Say what you think be honest!
- ⇒ Write down what the staff tell you so you will remember when you get home.
- \Rightarrow Phone if you have questions after your appointment.
- \Rightarrow Bring someone with you (for support and to help you remember what was said).
- \Rightarrow Ask your parents to wait outside the room if you want to discuss a 'personal matter' with the staff.
- \Rightarrow Ask your doctor to tell you everything.
